The Fire Protection Handbook® is a comprehensive resource for many topics related to fire prevention. This course will provide the students with a “hands-on” experience to more effectively and efficiently use the Fire Protection Handbook® for research purposes. The course will also serve as a means to prepare for the Certified Fire Protection Specialist® exam offered by NFPA®. Students will take multiple review exams and be provided with tips for organizing and using the Fire Protection Handbook®. This class is an intensive 3-day review and testing of the Fire Protection Handbook®. Students must apply for CFPS® testing and membership on their own. The NFPA® exam fee and application is not included with tuition.
